The Center for Digital Humanities is pleased to announce that we are accepting nominations for the Digital Humanities Dissertation Prize which recognizes exceptional doctoral work with a digital humanities component by recipients of Princeton PhDs. Applicants may self-nominate, as long as they secure a letter of recommendation from a Princeton faculty member.

Nominees for the 2019 prize must have defended their dissertation (FPO) between **January 1, 2019 and December 31, 2019**. Nominations will be accepted up until **May 4, 2020** (11:59 pm). The prize carries an award of **\$2,000**.

1. Dissertation abstract
2. Completed dissertation
3. Letter of recommendation from a faculty member (typically a dissertation adviser)

Please send the first two items as PDF attachments. Letters of recommendation should be sent separately to the same address (cdh-info@princeton.edu) and may be attached as PDFs or written in the text of an email. All materials, including letters of recommendation, must be received by the deadline.
